



## Curry County Board of REALTORS® 2022 COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

The Curry County Board of REALTORS (CCBR) is offering three \$1,000 scholarships through our Community Outreach program to enhance the education and resulting careers of three deserving Curry County high school students. One scholarship per area (south, central and north counties) will be awarded. Interested students who meet the qualifications are invited and encouraged to apply.

### SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

1. Applicant must be a 2022 graduating high school senior and reside in Curry County.
2. Applicant must be applying to attend full-time (12 hour minimum) at an accredited vocational school, technical school, college or university.
3. Applicant must have achieved a 3.0 or higher GPA.
4. Applicant must be of good character as evidenced by two letters of recommendation, one of which must come from a teacher, principal, or counselor at the education institution currently attending. The second must be from a community member, employer or volunteer organization. Letters from relatives are not accepted.
5. Applicants must have successfully held at least a part-time job, internship or volunteer position within the past two years.
6. Applicant must demonstrate a coherent degree plan and willingness to pursue a course of higher learning.
7. Applicant must provide a 1,000 word written essay on the selected essay question.
8. History of community involvement and potential for success of the applicant are considered.
9. Scholarships will be paid directly to applicant's graduating high school and then sent directly to the educational institution registrar's office.
10. Recipient must notify their high school upon receipt of acceptance letter to an accredited institution. If the recipient does not notify their high school by September 30, scholarship monies will be forfeited.
11. In the case of the recipient not attending the specified educational institution, failure to complete the semester or withdrawal from the institution; the full scholarship amount will be due for repayment by the recipient to CCBR within 30 days.
12. Applications are due no later than 5:00PM March 17, 2022.
13. Awards will be announced in May 2022.
14. The non-profit organization named in the applicant's essay will be awarded a \$500 donation by CCBR in the name of the applicant.
